- 1. Name of the deceased read by Stacey Beard.
- 2. Candle lighter or family member of the deceased comes forward and lights a candle.

3. Bell is rung.

4. Name of the deceased repeated.

5. Congregation response, "Present with the Lord".

6. Congregational prayer to be said in unison after all names have been read.
